

NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$0.2666 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Hardeman County Memorial Hospital District.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.2666 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.2666 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.2880 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2024 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Hardeman County Memorial Hospital District from the same properties in both the 2023 tax year and the 2024 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Hardeman County Memorial Hospital District may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Hardeman County Memorial Hospital District is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2024 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 6, 2024 AT 10 am AT 402 Mercer St, Quanah, TX; HCMH Board Room.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Hardeman County Memorial Hospital District is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Hardeman County Memorial Hospital District Board of Hardeman County Memorial Hospital District at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$

Memorial Hospital District last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by Hardeman County Memorial Hospital District this year.
